Background

The first Employment Rights Clinic was opened in the London Borough of Brent in June 2016.

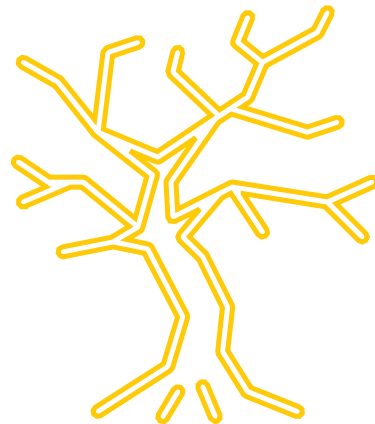
Three years later, with funding from the Trust for London, Tudor Trust, and the London Community Foundation among others, the Work Rights Centre has served over 2 000 + beneficiaries and developed lasting partnerships with communities across the city. In practice, beneficiaries are offered a wide range of support, including:

- help with claiming unpaid wages and fees;
- support with accessing statutory employment rights (such as unpaid holiday, or unfair dismissal);
- help in applying to Universal Credit;
- CVs and cover letter writing, interview practice and mentoring;
- assistance with applying for the EU Settlement Scheme (EUSS).

Branching Out

The Work Rights Centre opened the first Employment Rights Clinic in the **London Borough of Brent** in June 2016.

We began by offering 4 hours of pro bono casework a week, then gradually increased our service as soon as we were able to secure more funding. From January 2019 we have established the same model in **Manchester**.

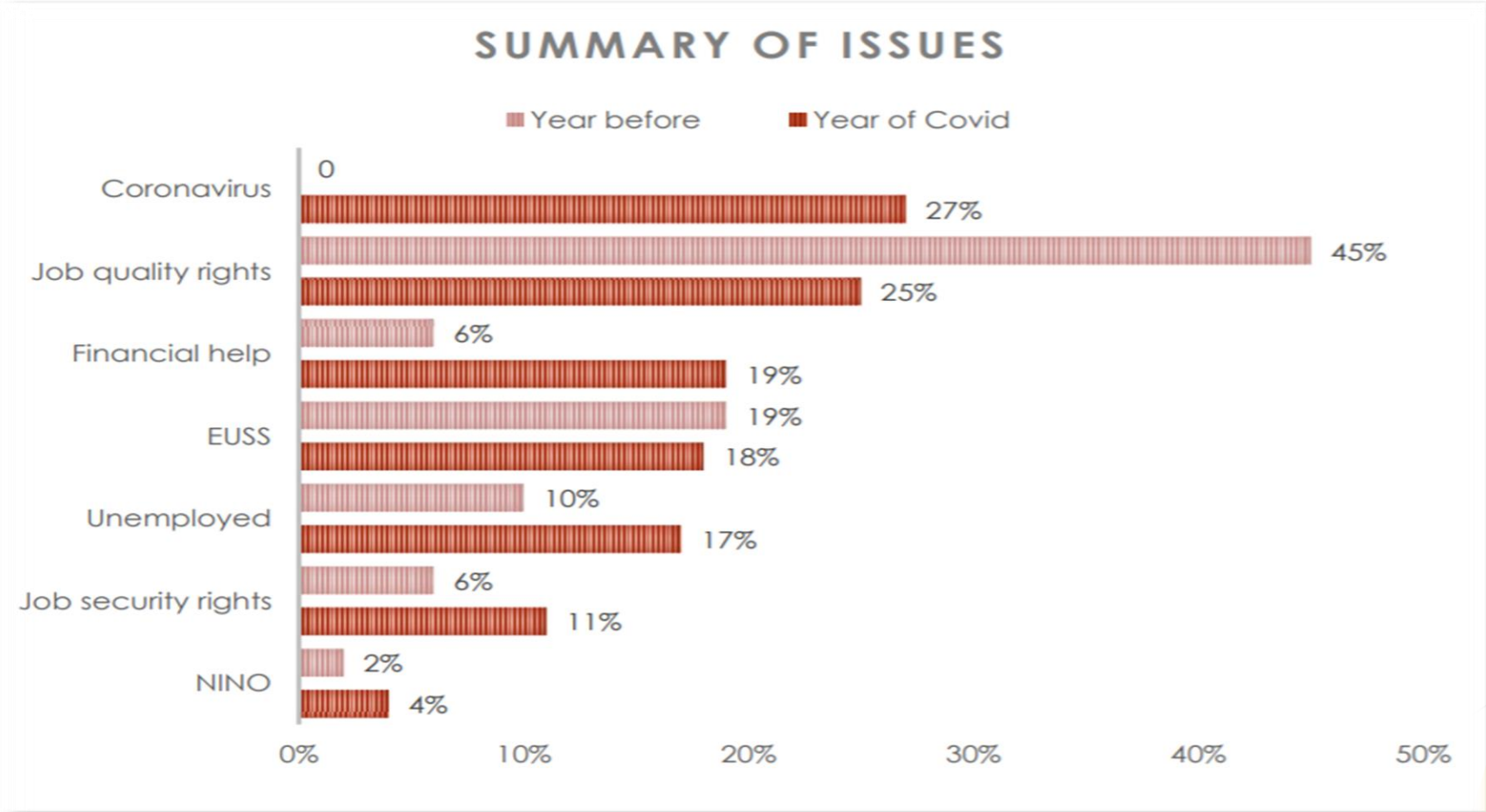

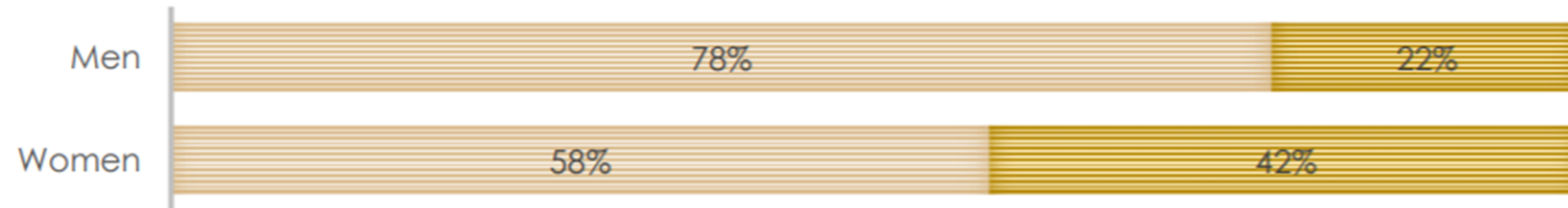
