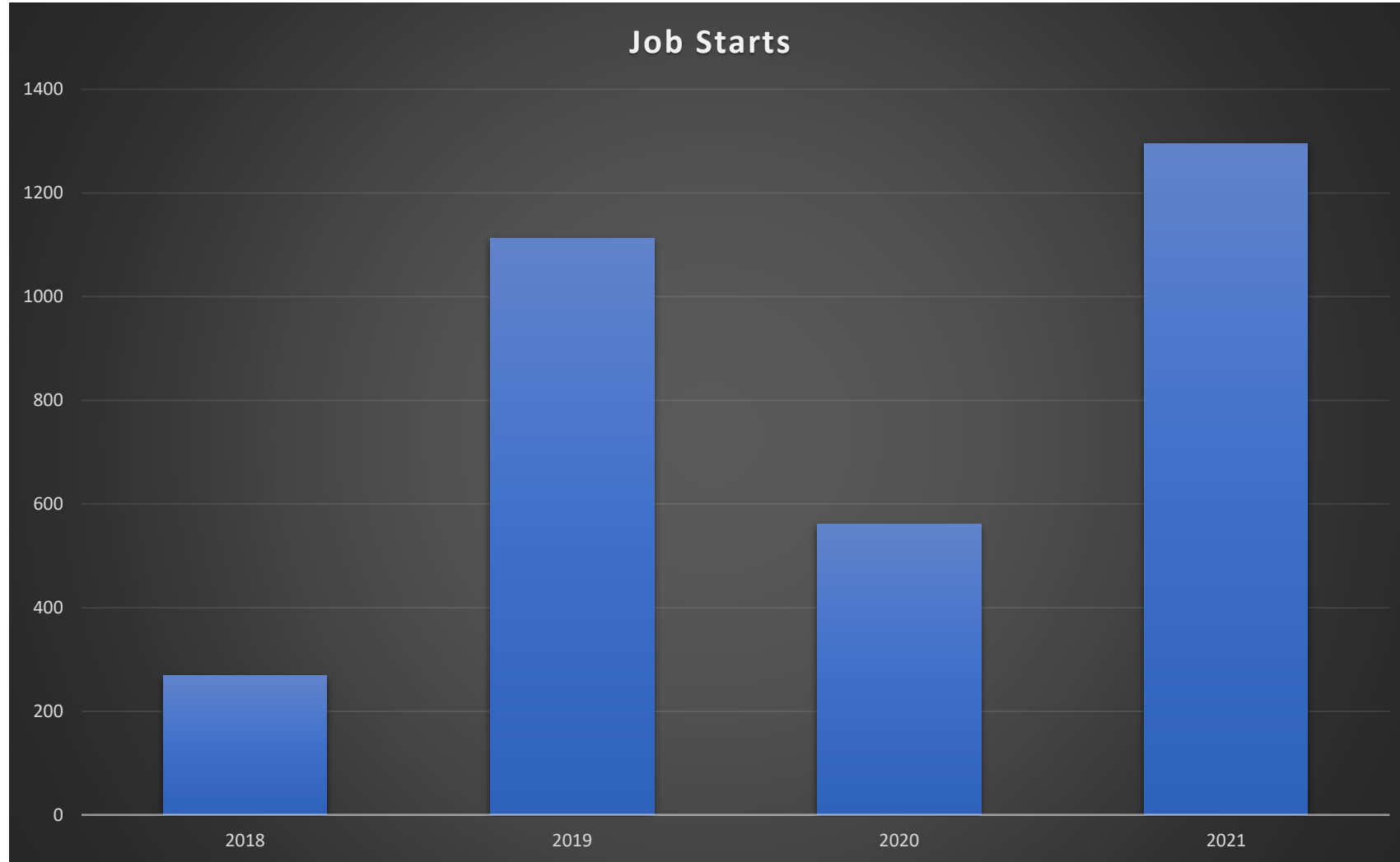

# What is the Work and Health Programme?

shaw trust

**Length:** Up to 15 months of support, plus in work support

**Delivery:** Face to Face and remote

**Who for:** Anyone with additional barriers to getting into work

Shaw Trust and the West London Alliance are the UK's number one Work and Health Programme provider.



- Someone who has a disability/health condition as defined by the Equality Act 2010
- An ex-offender
- A Carer or ex-carer
- A member of a family where a child is at risk of becoming Looked After
- A homeless person or someone at risk of becoming homeless
- A member or former member of Her Majesty's Armed Forces or Reserves
- A working age adult with disabilities known to Adult Services
- A partner of current or former Armed Forces personnel
- A person with a drug or alcohol dependency
- A care leaver
- A refugee
- A victim of domestic violence
- A young person in a gang
- Working age adult with a mental health condition known to secondary care services

They **do not** have to be claiming benefits

- Phase 1 – Overcome significant barrier
- Phase 2 – Upskilling
- Phase 3 – Employability

## **This includes but is not limited to:**

- Mental Health Support
- Physical Health Support
- Homelessness Advice
- Money and Debt Advice
- Access to third party agencies for help with disabilities
- Connections with charities that provide support for additional barriers
- Practical financial support

# Who is eligible for The JETS Programme?

shaw trust

- 18+
- Have the right to reside and enter employment in England.
- Be in receipt of Universal Credit and in the “Intensive Work Search Regime” group or New Style Jobseekers Allowance.
- Have been unemployed and in receipt of one of the above benefits for at least 13 weeks.
- Be motivated to find work and require light touch employment support.
