Community MARAC

- Identifies vulnerable individuals who are either victims or perpetrators of anti-social behaviour or crime.
- Age 18+ but tends to be older.
- Creates action plans to protect most vulnerable.
- Identify service gaps arising from cases discussed within the Community MARAC and raise these through the appropriate channels
- Links to Adult Safeguarding






Hirst Crescent, East Lane, Wembley, HA9 7HA CMARAC Case Study

- Flat being Cuckooed used by gang members.
- Referred to CMARAC - Case conference with stakeholders.
- Capacity assessment initiated through CMARAC.
- Partial Closure ASBCP2014.
- Temporary Accommodation.
- Cannot lead independently based on the capacity Assessment.
- Negotiated with housing to terminate the tenancy.
- Supported accommodation via Adult Social Care .
- Case Timeline: March 21- November 2022.



ASB Service Delivery



Challenges

- Mental Health assessment for those who are vulnerable. (no fixed abode)
- Information sharing/ Confidentiality
- Support Services requiring consent to engage with individuals.
- High levels of vulnerable people with complex needs in independent housing.
